What is Jump Start?

MSES is offering your child a fun approach to summer school this year!

Instead of the traditional four-week program in June—just after school's out and with months yet to go before it starts again—we'll offer students a fun but rigorous two-week reconnection with their literacy and math skills just before school starts again in August 2018.

Our main aim is to help energize and prepare students who struggle a little in school or who tend to lose skills over summer. With this new Jump Start, they will hit the ground running as the 2018-2019 school year begins!

*****Students will need to bring a daily snack, a pencil, and a wide-ruled spiral notebook.***

Key components:

- ◇ Small group direct guided reading and writing instruction.
- ◇ Daily practice with reading and writing.
- ◇ Hands-on math/literacy activities and games everyday.
- ◇ The opportunity to check out books from MSES school library.
- ◇ Snack time at our mid-morning play park break.
- ◇ At our last regular Friday session we will hold a reward party. Every child receives a book and will build a smoothie earned by reading at home.
- ◇ MSES instructors will present this program.



Who should enroll?

- ◇ Students who will benefit from positive, engaging practice in learning skills and strategies.
- ◇ Students who have difficulty retaining information over the summer and need to reconnect.
- ◇ Students who need to reach grade level in reading.
- ◇ Students who are having difficulty with math.
- ◇ Students with READ plans or individual reading plans (ILP's) or who are below grade level on reading and/or on math assessments.
- ◇ Students who, in general, struggle with classroom content.
- ◇ Students not proficient on Colorado state assessments.
- ◇ Certain students with learning disabilities (IEP's).
