# Mustang Safety Day Includes Mock Car Crash, Promotes Making Safe Choices

**Manitou Springs, CO** - Manitou Springs High School students will be observing what could happen if you choose to drive while under the influence. Mustang Safety Day is on Friday, April 14 – ahead of Prom. This training will include a mock car crash and several community partners. It's designed to raise awareness and provide resources to help students make safe choices.

There will be two separate events for Mustang Safety Day.

## Event 1: Mock Car Crash

**What:** Student actors will be role players involved in the accident. One student will be simulated to go into a helicopter for Flight For Life. Another student will have simulated visible injuries. The third student will simulate being the driver who may be under the influence.
